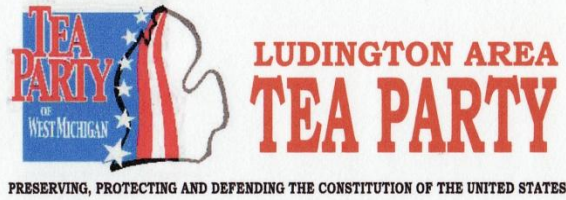

FEATURED SPEAKER: U.S. Senatorial Candidate [Randy Hekman](#) has served in the Navy as a Lieutenant, in the Kent County Prosecutor's Office, and as Kent County Probate-Juvenile Court Judge for 15 years. He had been Executive Director of CBH Ministries and just recently stepped down as executive pastor at Grand Rapid's Crossroads Bible Church to run for the U.S. Senate seat. He has special interest in Low Energy Nuclear Reaction (LENR) alternative energy research and technology. His stand on financial responsibility includes a balanced federal budget, taking aggressive action to begin paying off our nation's debt, deal realistically with entitlement programs, and encourage the non-profit sector to greatly increase its contribution to human need caused by the federal government's major reductions; consider a nominal tax credit for individuals who contribute at least 10 percent of their gross income to non-profit entities.
